

# Expanding Access to Emergency Care in Rural Hospitals

People from rural areas are more likely to die from an <u>accident</u> or having a <u>stroke</u>. They also get <u>more injuries from fires</u> compared to those living in urban areas. Providers with special training can use telehealth to assist staff in rural hospitals. This helps treat injuries quickly. In a medical emergency, faster care is critical.

Sanford Health has expanded emergency services through telehealth over many years. Sanford Health works with 32 emergency service locations. These are in rural areas in South Dakota, North Dakota, and Minnesota. This partnership helps rural emergency staff quickly speak with specialists. The specialists provide guidance on treating strokes, burns, and other medical traumas.

When a patient arrives at a rural emergency room, staff promptly respond. They use a virtual care hub to start a live video connection. The virtual hub connects the rural emergency staff to a specialist. This helps increase access and works to prevent avoidable deaths.

Technology is key to the program's success. The tele-emergency team uses two large monitors. This allows specialists to view patient information from six different sources at the same time. These different pieces of information help the emergency physician identify the best treatment. Learn more on hhs.gov.

#### **Iran-based Cyber Actors Enabling Ransomware Attacks on US Organizations**

CISA, FBI, and the Department of Defense Cyber Crime Center (DC3) have published a joint Cybersecurity Advisory (CSA) highlighting ongoing ransomware attacks by Iran-based cyber actors targeting U.S. and international organizations, including those in education, finance, healthcare, defense, and local government. These actors, associated with the Iranian government, use their access to collaborate with ransomware affiliates to deploy ransomware and steal sensitive data. The advisory details their tactics, techniques, and procedures (TTPs) and provides updates from a previous advisory on the exploitation of virtual private network (VPN) vulnerabilities. Known under various names such as Pioneer Kitten and Br0k3r, this group also engages in computer network exploitation to support Iranian state interests, conducting operations like the 2020 Pay2Key hackand-leak campaign aimed at undermining Israeli infrastructure. # HHS Secretary Becerra Hosts Roundtable with Health Care Leaders to Address the Shortage of Blood Culture Media Bottles


