

#### Description...

- What if a catastrophic event occurs?
- Will you be ready?
- Will you need a special level of protection?
- Is decontamination necessary?
- Do you have the right medications?
  - This course answers these questions and more as you learn how to distinguish between different agents of concern that could be used in an incident. A combination of facilitated discussions, smallgroup exercises, human patient simulator hands-on scenarios, and traditional classroom discussions are used to present the topics. The multi-discipline make-up of the participants helps to strengthen information sharing, communications, and medical surge capabilities.

- Planning and Preparing for the Hazardous/ Active Threat Environment
- Identifying and Responding to a Hazardous/ Active Threat Environment using the RAPIDCare algorithm
- Personal protective measures and equipment for the Hazardous/Active Threat Environment
- Identifying and caring for victims exposed to a Chemical, Biological, Radiological/Nuclear (CBRN) agent
- Decontamination of victims exposed to a Chemical, Biological, Radiological/Nuclear (CBRN) agent
- Triage and medical care of casualties during a CBRNE incident, Complex Coordinated Terrorist Attack or Active Shooter/Hostile Event

### **Using ICS in a Local Public Health Response**

Registration is now open on MN.TRAIN (<u>https://www.train.org/mn</u>) for "Using ICS in a Local Public Health Response" Course ID <u>1075366</u>.

MDH developed this course for local public health staff and it's highly recommended staff complete IS 100 and IS 200 before taking this training. This is a one-and-a-half day, hands-on training/workshop where local public health staff will have the opportunity to prepare and execute a response strategy to a simulated public health incident by reviewing and then applying Incident Command principles. Participants should bring their laptop computer. LPH/TH can use PHEP or RSG funds to attend this training (travel reimbursement, hotel stay, etc.,) You can download materials for this training on the Emergency Preparedness for CHB/THD SharePoint site, on the <u>ICS for LHD/THD sub page</u>. We will also bring the materials on a flash drive if you have trouble downloading materials from SharePoint.

Specific times and locations are listed in MN.TRAIN. Scheduled workshops are as follows:

1. Central and West Central Region – Buffalo, MN – November 20/21st.

Objectives for the course:

- 1. Review Incident Command System (ICS) positions and responsibilities and assume role in a simulated response
- 2. Develop SMART incident response objectives, identify strategies and tactics, and hold incident briefing
- 3. Review the Planning P phases and the ICS forms used in each phase to develop an Incident Action Plan
- 4. Identify next steps for applying the ICS process and tools for planned and emergency response with their agencies

Day One – Half day, 12:30 p.m. – 4:30 p.m. (limited snacks and water provided) Day Two – Full day, 8:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. (Eat before or bring your own breakfast. Lunch and limited snacks and water provided.)
